Developers have poured millions into the new buildings that dot this area of the waterfront, and SHI is appropriately stunning—with floor-to-ceiling windows offering breathtaking views of the Manhattan skyline; sexy white leather plush chairs flanking the beautiful bar area; and a dining room dripping in crystal chandeliers. So how does the food fit into all this?
